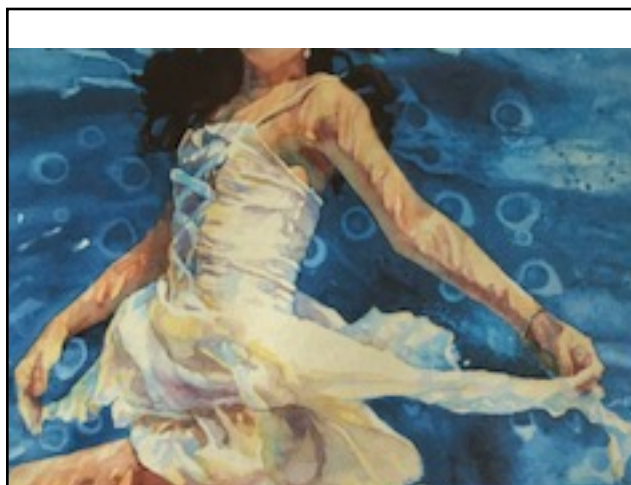

July Program presents Karen St. Clair

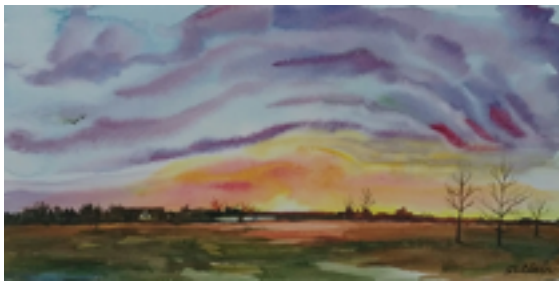
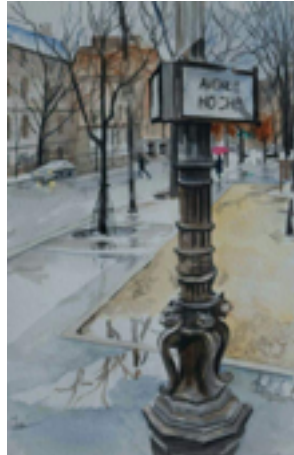
