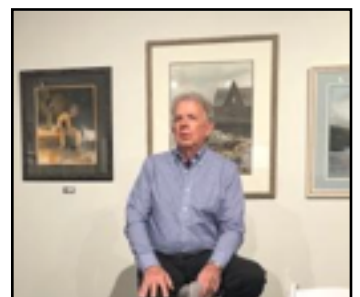

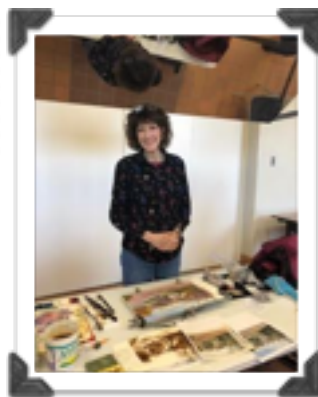
Jim Buchan offered an half-day watercolor class to nine members of the Bartlesville Art Association March 27.
