Oklahoma Art Workshops enabled Joanne to study with the countries leading watercolor teachers during the 1980's and 90's. The teachers who influenced her the most were Frank Webb, Claude Croney, Christopher Schink and Don Andrews.



Joanne taught watercolor at Zieglers, Triangle and Hobby Lobby for more than twelve years and still teaches a class at her home. Her work was shown at several galleries in Tulsa and then as a member of Arts Limited on Peoria and then as a member of Color Connection Gallery at Utica Square. She gave a demonstration painting roses at the National Rose convention, held in Tulsa and was published in their national magazine.

To people who admire watercolor but say they can't paint or even draw stick figures, I say, if you have the desire, anyone can learn to paint. It brings a lifetime of being aware of the beauty all around you.
