Thank You Grant Denny For A Very Interesting Presentation

Grant Denny presented a variety of mounting methods and materials for watercolor paper, explaining the importance of each.



His focus was on hinge T- mounting watercolor paper to foam board. This mounting technique involved the use of rice paper strips and a home-made rice glue. "Applying diluted acrylic gel medium to the surface of illustration board (Strathmore 500 series hot-press) enhances the results of watercolor. When sweeping a broad brush charged with color over the medium-coated surface, the paint immediately repels and creates exciting textures... (Cheng-Khee Chee)
