The Members show is a go go go!

GCWS is about to enter into new technological territory. The 2020 Member Show will be presented as a Digital Online Show. Board members Jim Buchan, Jo Lynch, Molly Jo Blankenship, Dede Burgess and Jeanette Hooks met May 27 at Jeanette's home to discuss and plan this new and exciting digital format for our Members Show.

An amazing amount of discussion and planning went into deciding on the solution to this question. The board believes we will have a much greater number of entries because of the cost savings to members (no matting and framing). The show will also have the potential of a much larger audience, opening up access to a far-reaching audience that is virtually impossible with the traditional box venue. The show will be published on the GCWS website.

This will be so easy for members that there is no reason why every single member should not enter at least one painting.

Here's how it works:

- Paintings will NOT be matted or framed! (a big saving to you)
- Paintings will be presented as digital photographs. This can be achieved in one of two ways...

- 1. Unframed paintings would be dropped off to Jo Lynch who has arranged a professional photographer to produce digital images of your paintings at no cost to you. (Preferred choice)
- 2. You may do your own photography and email the files to Jo lynch. (professional quality photography required)
