August Meeting Program Was Presented By

2020 Award Winner Iván Alvarez

Iván was our guest speaker at the August meeting. As recipient of the 2020 OSU Scholarship Award, Iván displayed some of his art and presented an interesting explanation of its concept and development.



Artist’s Statement: My name is Iván Alvarez, and I am from Owasso, Oklahoma. I am currently working towards achieving my BFA in Studio Art from Oklahoma State University. Much of my art explores the connection between a human subject and the space they occupy both physically and emotionally. The backdrop or interaction between maps and the human displays the unavoidable relationship between emotions and places. A map is a guidance tool that leads people together or apart. The use of maps as a medium for my art carries a connotation of myself finding and being found. The idea of displaying literal paths leading in every direction explores the idea that I am finding myself trapped in spaces or in people that lead me nowhere. When I first started using maps as a medium I had been in a long distance relationship and I felt that it helped me deal with the space between my emotions. After the relationship had ended I continually found myself circling back to using this space as an outlet for self discovery and to wrestle with my emotions.
