Jim's comments about the class:

"Our class will be from 9:30 - 12:30 at our studio location.

"What you can expect: I will provide a subject for the class to paint and a line drawing that can be used to transfer using our light box. Additionally I will provide examples of my cards from the



past 20 years - they might be helpful and provide “inspiration” for your own design. Or you may paint your own card design. The point is, regardless of the subject - it will be a wonderful opportunity to paint!!
