WE are all totally aware of the COVID-19 issues! So - the class will enforce all protocol standards - ie MASK AND 6 FEET SEPARATION. (This is still better than painting alone at home!)

Many thanks to our board member Jim Grisham and his church, South Tulsa Baptist Church! They have invited us to use one of their recreation rooms for our painting class. The church wishes area residents, which includes us, to use their facility. Fridays are usually a "quite" day for most churches- so - it fits our needs.

COST: "FREE" - except 2021 dues (\$35) must be paid. Otherwise cost is \$25.

**INSTRUCTIONS**: Teresa Herndon will teach the February class. Teresa is an excellent teacher.

**LOCATION**: South Tulsa Baptist Church. 10310 S. Sheridan (103rd and Sheridan). Park on the west side - use the southwest door - we will have signs directing you to room C141.

**REFRESHMENTS**: GCWS will provide free donuts- but you should plan to bring your own coffee, water, etc.

**REGISTRATION**: ONLY ONE WAY - send the instructor an email. Teresa's email is herndontw@aol.com


Upon receiving your email the instructor will - in turn - email you the photo of the subject matter plus a line drawing. (This will also help us set up chairs and tables)

**ADDITIONAL DETAILS**: We will provide a light box for transferring but everyone should try to arrive with it transferred onto a 1/4 sheet. Don't worry about colors - just bring your normal pallet. THIS WILL BE A SIMPLE PAINTING WHICH WE CAN ALL COMPLETE IN 2 1/2 HOURS.


