Date: April 28 (Wednesday)

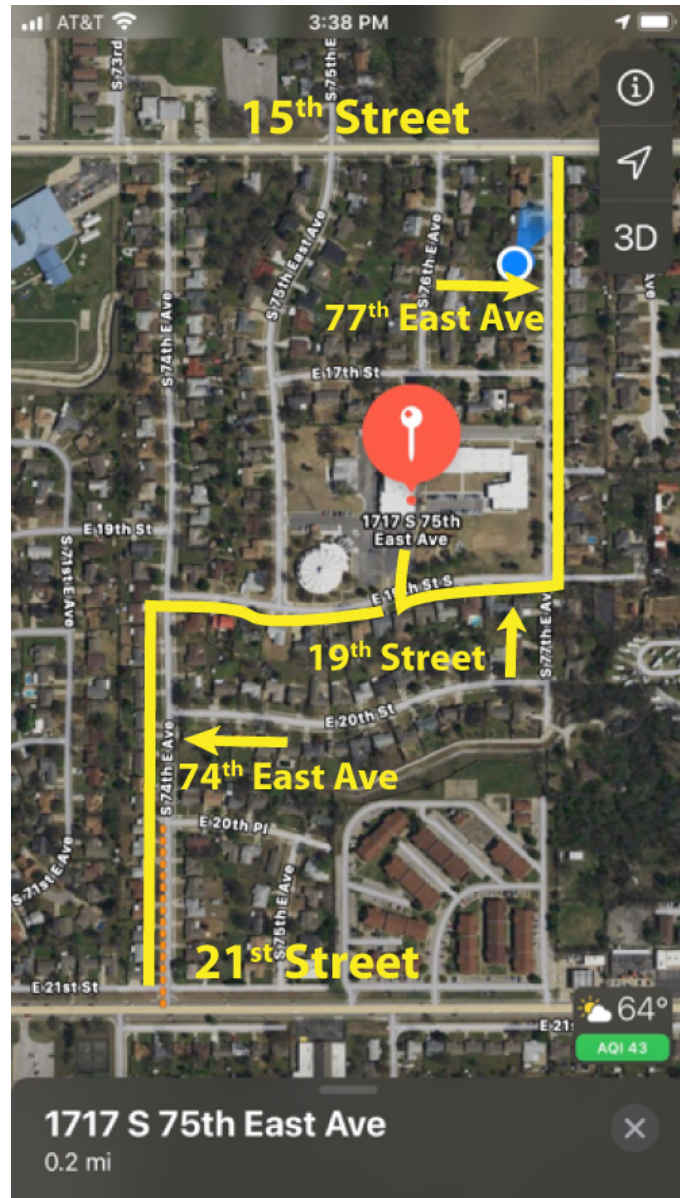
Time: 9 a.m. to noon

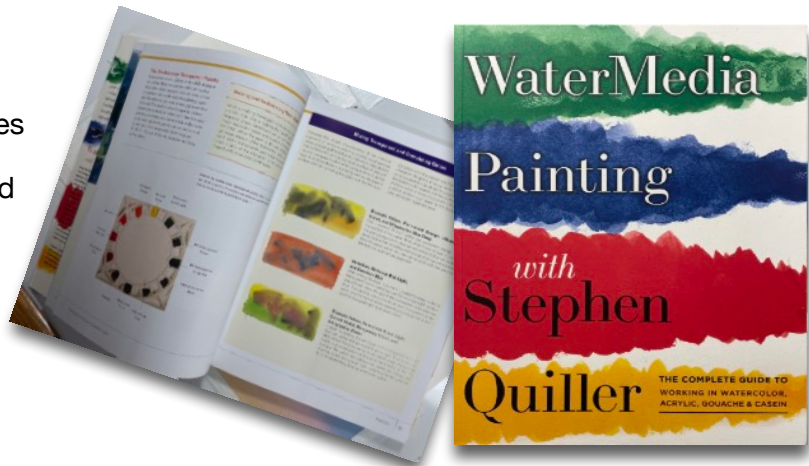
