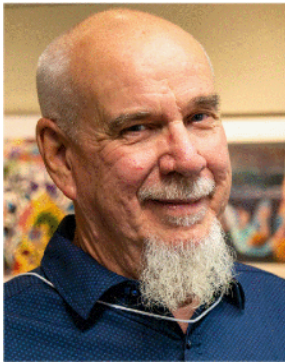

Stan Kurth is a well know watercolor artist specializing in abstract composition and design. This workshop is designed to teach all levels of students to paint intuitively, starting without preconceived notions or outcome. There will be no preliminary planning or drawing. Process will dictate direction as students use ink pen, watercolor and gouache to implement elements and principles of design. Instruction will start with random marks, then color using a mixture of watercolor and gouache to create a library of design elements. There will be much discussion on the definition of intuitive painting. There will also be regular comments and evaluation of student work in progress, mostly concerning relationships between elements and principles. It is entirely possible that finished work may be representational, but the goal is work which is compositionally pleasing and aligned with the artist's personal aesthetic. —❖—

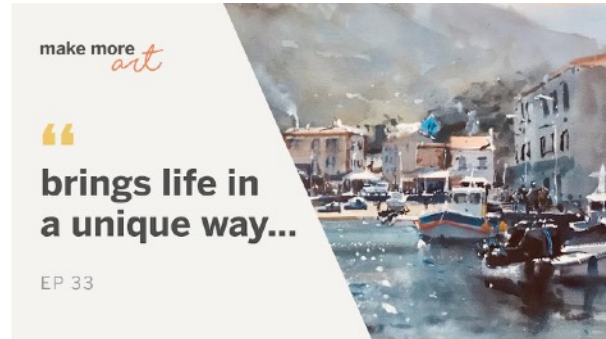
