## January 11 Program – Monte Toon

In 1969, Monte Toon began his career as a watercolorist. Knowledge of and a feeling for the subject are keys to Toon's current works. More than 54 years' experience has defined Toon's style in his exclusive use of watercolor. Toon is a signature member of *Watercolor Honor Society* and the *Kansas Watercolor Society*.

In 1991, a turning point occurred in Toon's work. Travels in Canada, New England, and the east coast broadened his range of subject matter. By setting goals and directions of purpose, Monte enhanced and elevated his works to new heights resulting in numerous solo shows of merit. He refers to this change as a re-dedication to his watercolors. His first major solo show was held in 1994. The exhibit titled "Journeys" contained over 50 full sheet (22"x 30") original watercolors.



Monte will discuss the three paintings that were juried into three years of the annual USA Watercolor Exhibit at Springfield Art Museum. Each painting required a different approach and showcases the qualities needed to meet the judge's acceptance and his personal goal of achieving Signature Status. Additionally, Monte will demonstrate his use of masking to "save" areas of the white paper and provide sparkle to his works.
